In line with Section 216 (1) of the PIA 2021, which requires the Commission to consult with stakeholders prior to finalizing regulations or amendments to regulations, the Nigerian Upstream Petroleum Regulatory Commission (NUPRC) hereby invites inputs from Lessees, Licensees, Permit holders, Host Communities and other stakeholders of the Nigerian Upstream Petroleum sector, within 21 days from the date of this publication.
